CAMP POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- The guiding rule at Creativity Camp is BE KIND... to your self, other people, things, supplies, etc. Parents will be contacted if necessary to help reinforce the standard.
 - Creativity Camp begins at 9:00 am and ends at 4:00 pm, with drop-off beginning at 8:30 am and regular pick-up between 4-4:30 pm. **Before and After Care is available for members.**
 - Before Care begins at 7:30 am, After Care ends promptly at 6:00pm. Late pick-up fees for non-members will be charged at the rate of \$10 for the first 15-minutes (or any part thereof) and \$5 for each additional 5-minute period after 6:15pm. Time will be recorded by camp staff and billed through the Common Space Office.
 - Campers should pack a lunch - a refrigerator is available. Art supplies and drinks are provided.
 - Lunch is noon-1pm in the outdoor Pavilion with playground recess following. Water bottles are permitted throughout the day and are the responsibility of the camper. No gum indoors please!
 - Campers will only be released to parents and/or individuals listed on their Camper Pick-Up Authorization Form. Any changes to the list, permanent or temporary, must be made in writing. Campers must be signed out each day even when leaving early for other appointments, etc.
 - An Emergency Contact/Consent Form must be completed and on file for each camper.
 - Medication will not be dispensed without a signed and written authorization from parents or guardians. Forms will be provided when requested and faxed to the office at 419-531-5049.
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OTHER CREATIVITY CAMP INFO

- We maintain our facilities, but clothing may possibly come home with paint or stains as we sit on floors, play theatre games, play outside, dance and work with some messy art supplies. Clothing should be loose enough to allow freedom of movement. Paint shirts are available daily.
 - Each Friday afternoon the Camper's Showcase begins at 4:00 pm for parents, siblings and friends! Please attend as many as you can, the campers love to see you there!
 - Feel free to send sunscreen, hats, or jackets with campers. They will spend a portion of each lunch period outside (weather permitting). Electronic games and toys are discouraged.
